- Who was Florence Nightingale and when did she live? Florence Nightingale was a nurse who lived over 200 years ago (1820-1910)
- How successful was Florence Nightingale at Scutari hospital? Florence Nightingale was very successful at raising the standards of cleanliness in hospitals and patient care. She even ran a women's hospital in London after returning from the Crimea.
- Who was Mary Seacole and when did she live? Mary Seacole was also a nurse who lived over 200 years ago (1805-1881)
- How did Mary Seacole improve the lives of soldiers in the Crimean war? Mary Seacole set up a hotel for wounded British soldiers to recover and provided them with a place to stay, food and care.
- What are the similarities and differences between Mary Seacole and Florence Nightingale? Both of them were nurses during the Crimean War and they helped lots of soldiers. One was born in Britain and the other was born in Jamaica
