

Home Learning

Please continue listen to your children read at least 4 times a week to help increase their fluency. It is also important to ask questions to check whether your child understands the text. If you require any support with this then please let me know. In addition, the children will receive weekly spelling home learning. This will be given out on a Friday and collected in the following Friday. This will include a worksheet in their home learning books and also a follow up activity online on the Spelling Shed website. The children's log in details will be stuck in the front of their home learning books. We are also going to be setting maths work to consolidate the learning we have done in class each week.

Maths

We will be learning about:

- Finding and recognising fractions - half, quarter and thirds
- Time
- Statistics

- Learning about colour and shade and mixing colours
- Painting in the style of Kandinsky

Science
