

## **Home Learning**

This will be given out on a Friday and collected in the following Friday. This will include a worksheet in their home learning books and also a follow up activity online on the Spelling Shed website. The children's log in details will be stuck in the front of their home learning books. We are also going to be setting maths work to consolidate the learning we have done in class each week.

### **Maths**

We will be learning about:

- Temperature, capacity and mass
- Position and direction
- Time
- Revising the four operations and written methods

### **English**

Our project will be closely linked with English sessions where children will be developing our writing skills by writing instructions, a letter and a non-chronological report.

### **Art & DT**

### **Science**

We will be learning about seasonal changes and revisiting our previous learning. This will include visits to our wildlife area and pond.

### **PE**

Jays will be working on send and return ball skills and how these apply to games. We will also be practising throwing and catching with different objects.

### **Computing**

This term, we will be using iPads to create music. We will be linking this to our learning in music this term.

### **Music**

We will enjoy exploring music by Shostakovich and practising finding rhythms and tempo.

### **PSHE**

We will learn more about how to look after our wellbeing.

We will learn about our value of friendship. In Jigsaw lessons with Mrs Riddiford, we will look at the theme 'Relationships'.

### **RE**

We will be considering the following big question: "How do we celebrate our journey through life?" and visiting the church.

### **History**

We will learning about how holidays have changed over time. This involves a local study and the influence of the railways on Weston-super-Mare in Victorian times. This will link to our trip in Term 6 where we will visit the seaside!
