Each week concentrates on a different times table, with a recommended consolidation week for rehearsing the tables that have recently been practiced. Insight
Pupil data recorded: Pupil names, date of birth, your child's UPN (individual school DFE reference number), their attendance records, teacher assessments and statutory assessment data from Y2 & Y6 SATS, Year 1 Phonics Screening Check and the Year 4 Multiplication Check. Insight is an online assessment tracking system which is used by all of the school within LSP. We use INSIGHT to compile all of our assessment data for the children at St Andrew's Primary School. INSIGHT is also used to monitor attendance and to analyse the demographics of our school cohort.



Provision Map
Pupil data recorded: Pupil name, date of birth, UPN and class. An online tool which allows us to set, review and monitor learning targets for children with additional needs.



Jigsaw Online
Pupil data recorded: names and class. An online platform to replace our existing paper copies of PSHE resources that we use across the school.



CPOMS collects information from behaviour and attendance records, SEN records, EHC Plans, Safeguarding, records and from other sources. CPOMS links into school's Management Information.



The PE Hub
Pupil data collected: names, classes and abilities. The system tracks pupils progress and serves as an assessments tracker.



Speech and language UK
The Speech and language UK Talk Boost intervention is carried out across EYFS and KS1. The system tracks and monitors pupil progress throughout the intervention process.



GL Assessment offers a dyslexia screener which gives either a low/medium/high probability of dyslexia. The personal data required is full name, date of birth and unique pupil number. This is only collected for individual pupils and parental consent is gained prior to this information being uploaded onto the website.

This form lists the apps and websites that either require any personal data via the login or include image use. Other apps and websites are used by children to support their education and in line with our responsible internet usage guidelines. All internet access is supervised.

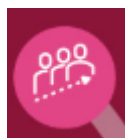

Nurture UK Principles



Nurture principle- The importance of transition in children's lives

St Andrews 'child talk'- We talk and prepare for change in our lives.

At St Andrews, we appreciate that transitions for children both big and small can be hard and so we try our best to prepare them for transitions in their lives. Small transitions at school can be things like coming in from the playground, lining up for assembly and moving from the carpet to tables. Some children can find these transitions difficult for various reasons such as too much noise, too many people and not knowing what is going to happen next. Every class has a visual timetable so that children know what is happening and when so they are prepared for changes and they understand why something is happening. Staff inform children of last-minute changes

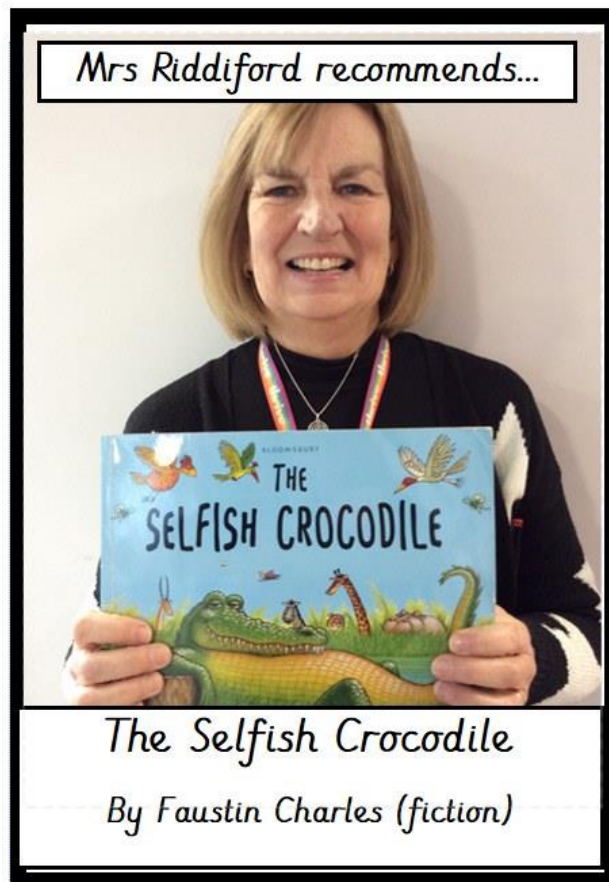
and explain the reasons behind them. All staff are aware that these last-minute changes whilst inevitable can unsettle the children and thus affect their behaviour. Big transitions at school can be things like moving into a new class, moving to a new school and finishing their time in the Nest or Haven. Staff carefully plan ways in which they can help ease transition for the children so that they can be as positive as they can be.

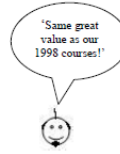
