**Aerial Photograph:** A photo taken from the air.

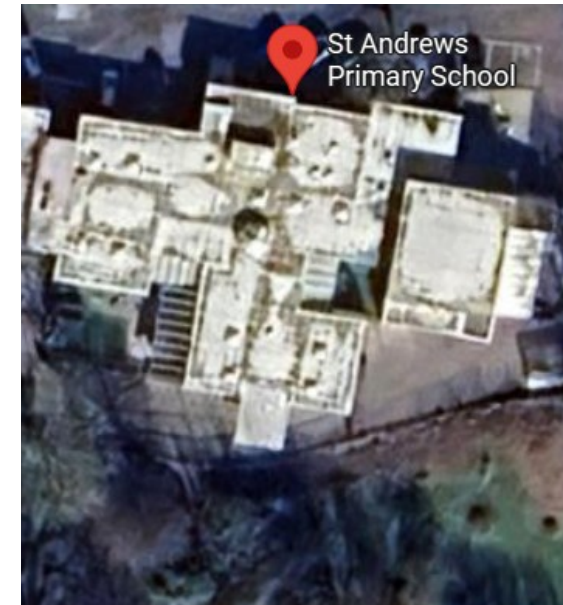
**Fieldwork:** Collecting information from outside.

**Job:** Regular work which is usually paid.

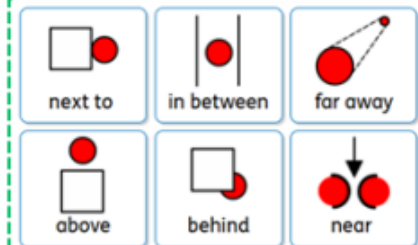
**Routes:** A route shows the start and end of a journey.
