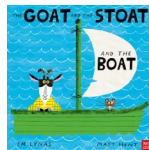
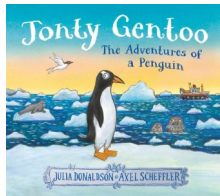
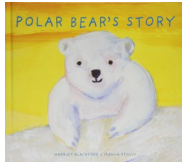


Personal, Social and Emotional

As a crew we will be celebrating Chinese New Year and trying out Chinese food.



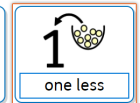
Physical Development
