

Home Learning

Please continue to listen to your children read at least 4 times a week to help increase their fluency and also ask questions to check whether your child understands the text. World Book Day is in week 2 on Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> March and we hope you can support your child with the activities.

The children will receive weekly spelling home learning. This will be given out on a Wednesday and collected in the following Wednesday.

We are also going to be using an online game called TT Rock stars to help children with fluency in 2x, 5x and 10x tables. Log in details will be in the home learning books shortly.

English

In English lessons we will be:

- Writing a diary entry based on the book *The Café at the End of the Woods* by Mikey Please
- Continue to embed capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
- Learn some new features that we can include in our writing including conjunctions and apostrophes.

Maths

We will be learning about:

- Finding and recognising fractions - half, quarter and thirds
  - Times Tables 2x, 5x, 10x
- Properties of shape and symmetry
