1. Review British Values

Can you remember the four British values?

Individual Liberty

Rule of Law

Democracy

Mutual Respect and Tolerance

How can we remember them? Today we are focussing on Rule of Law.

2. Why have rules and laws?

Let's play a game with three rules:

Green - Walk

Amber - Slow motion

Red - Freeze

(Leaders say a word, and rest of children follow rule)

What would happen if you could take whatever you want?

Discuss why having rules is important.

What are our school rules? Why is it important to have school rules?

What is in your Class Contract? How does it help?

3. Rules for games at playtime

It has been noticed that some children are struggling at playtime when playing games. Sometimes this might be because the rules aren't clear or maybe not all children are following the rules

What games do you play at playtime that might need clearer rules? Perhaps tag or football?

How could you make the rules clearer so that everyone knows what to do?
