


<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Home Learning</u></p> <p>Please continue to listen to your child read at least 4 times a week to help increase their fluency and also ask questions to check whether your child understands the text. The children will receive weekly spelling home learning. This will be given out on a Wednesday and collected in the following Wednesday.</p> <p>We will continue to be using an online game called TT Rock stars to help children with fluency in 2x 5x and 10x tables. Log in details will be in the home learning books. Any other practise of times tables e.g. songs, flash cards, etc. is also useful!
