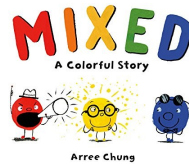
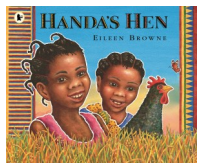
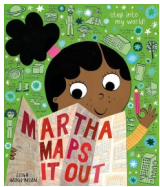


## Personal, Social and Emotional
