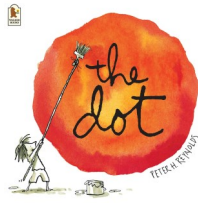
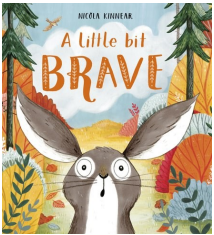


Personal, Social and Emotional

The children will have the opportunity to develop their creative skills through painting, collage, modelling, cutting and sticking and drawing.



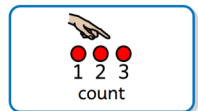
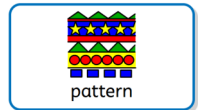
Physical Development
