

English

This term, the children will explore *The Barnabus Project*, *The Lost Thing* and *Escape from Pompeii* through a range of writing styles. They will write explanations, character descriptions and non-chronological reports, developing their vocabulary, sentence structure and ability to organise their ideas clearly.

Maths

This term, the children will develop their understanding of place value and learn how numbers are represented and partitioned. They will then build their skills in addition and subtraction, using a range of methods to solve calculations and problems.



Science

This term, the children will explore how sound is made and how it travels. They will investigate different sounds and vibrations, and carry out experiments to discover how sounds can change in pitch and volume.



History

This term, the children will learn about the Romans and their impact on Britain. They will explore the Roman invasion, everyday life, settlements and the legacy the Romans left behind.



Art

Children will explore the theme of *People and Places* through drawing, painting and watercolour. They will develop their observational skills and experiment with colour, shape and different techniques, including pointillism, to create their own artwork inspired by people and places around them.
