There won't be a meeting for Robin crew parents as they met Mrs Dyson at the home visits at the start of this term.

It is the season where we all can pick up mild illnesses of colds and coughs! This week, at the DfE's request, the Chief Medical Officer has written a letter to Headteachers to provide a clinical and public health perspective on mild illnesses and school attendance - setting out the health benefits of regular school attendance.

The key message is that it is usually appropriate for parents and carers to send their children to school with mild respiratory illnesses. This would include general cold symptoms: a minor cough, runny nose or sore throat. **However, children should not be sent to school if they have a temperature of 38°C or above**. There is a really helpful document that give guidance on common illnesses and what to do including if your child has COVID: https://www.nhs.uk/live-well/is-my-child-too-ill-for-school/

With this in mind, the School Nursing Team – Sirona will be holding Flu Nasal Vaccination session in school on **Wednesday, 04 October**. They kindly request for parents to fill in an online e-consult form to advise if they wish for their child/children to be vaccinated. The deadline for submitting the form is **Monday, 02 October at 9am**. More details and a link to the form in the letter from Sirona below. Please be advised that the school does not collect consent/lack of consent information for the Medical Team.

Nasal Flu Vaccination Programme

This autumn all children from Reception to Year 11 are being offered a flu vaccine as part of the School Vaccination Programme. This letter explains why children are being offered this vaccine and explains how to let us know whether or not you would like your child to be vaccinated.

Children are being offered the vaccinations to protect them from flu, minimise the circulation of the virus this winter and to reduce disruption to their education, and the potential impact on the NHS. The vaccinations will be given by Sirona care & health, who run all the School Immunisation Programmes in our area.

The flu vaccine is administered using a nasal spray.

Please complete the consent form below, indicating whether you wish your child to have the vaccine. If you don't have access to the internet, you can request a paper copy from your child's school.

Please complete the form as soon as possible, the consent system will be closed at 9am 2 working days before the session. Your school will tell you the date of the session once it is confirmed.

Please ensure you complete the consent form even if you do not want your child to receive the vaccination

If your child is not able to attend school on the day of the Immunisation session they can attend a catch-up clinic at a later date. Your school will send out information about these clinics after the school session.
